## This Month's Guest Speaker - Phil Spence

Phil Spence is one of the world's leading experts on New Guinea orchids and the Latouria section of the genus *Dendrobium*. Phil is a highly respected orchid grower, researcher and hybridiser and has been a major supplier of Dendrobium section Latouria species and hybrids and other highly desirable orchid genera for many years. Phil's background in the orchids of Papua New Guinea comes from having worked there for a number of years.

Phil is also an honorary research associate at the NSW Royal Botanic Gardens with projects on latouriatype New Guinea dendrobiums, and breeding cool growing hybrids of high altitude.

Phil has been recorded in the past as saying regarding his regular trips to PNG "I've been there 50 or 60 times, and every time I go there I have found new species of plants."
