ANOS Sydney Current Competitions

With the new Growing Competition, commencing March 2016, the following summary is provided to clarify the four areas where members may show their growing skills.

1. Annual Points Score Competition

Members may bench plants at Monthly Meetings from January to November inclusive. Judges decide on the three placings in each class. Points are allocated for 1st, 2nd and 3rd in each class and to each plant benched.

Points are tallied after the November meeting with the winner and other placings announced at the December Christmas party. A full rundown of results will be included in the January 2017 Orchdophile.

2. The Australian Orchid Nursery Popular Vote Competition

This completion is sponsored by The Australian Orchid Nursery for 2016. It is designed to encourage members to bench plants at each monthly meeting.

Members may bench plants at Monthly Meetings from January to November inclusive. Members vote on their three plant choices at each meeting with the top 3 grower placings announced on the night.

Points are tallied after the November meeting from the three grower placings each month with the winner and other placings announced at the December Christmas party. A full rundown of results will be included in the January 2017 Orchidophile.

3. Growing Competition – Starting September 2014

4. Growing Competition – Starting March 2016

This competition runs concurrently with the September 2014 Growing Competition but will finish later. Members are reminded they will again have the opportunity to purchase the growing competition plants for this year at the April meeting. Plants are \$6 each and will be allocated randomly at the meeting. Any remaining plants will be sold or raffled as non competition plants.
